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INTRODUCTION

This publication consists of 13 chapters focusing on particular subject matter area for facilitating the users in accordance with their requirement. Like many other publications of BBS, the Monthly Statistical Bulletin has proven to be a unique source of information in the wide range of socio-economic issues pertaining to Bangladesh.

Rounding of Figures:

In many cases figures have been rounded off to the nearest final digit (in cases of thousand, million, lakh, crore, etc.). This may lead to slight discrepancy between the sum of constituent items and total. In such cases, however, the total figure should be used instead of sum of the constituent items.

Greater District:

"Greater district" is used to denote the former 21 districts functioning before the creation of new 64 districts. Greater district is identical with "Statistical Region" used in the earlier issues of the Monthly Statistical Bulletin.
